Even when it is very difficult, we cannot give up, because we have hope.

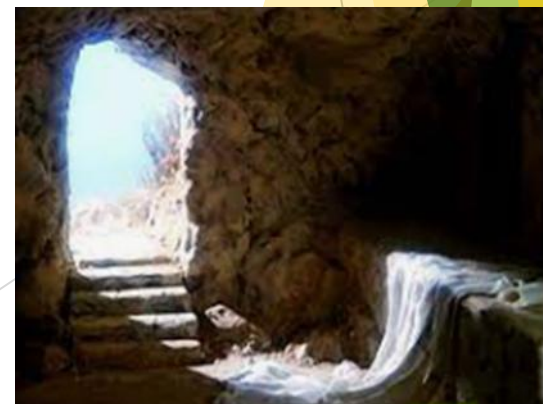
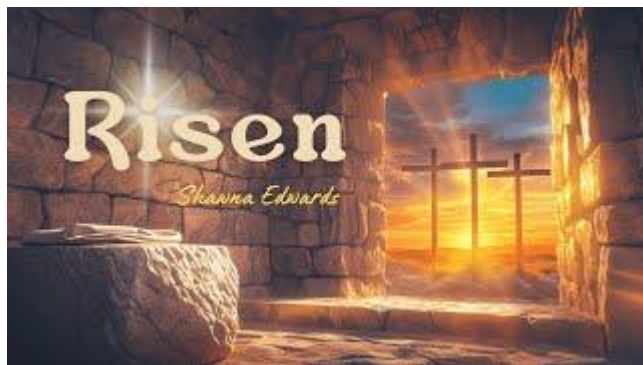


What makes you joyful this Easter?

fairer place?

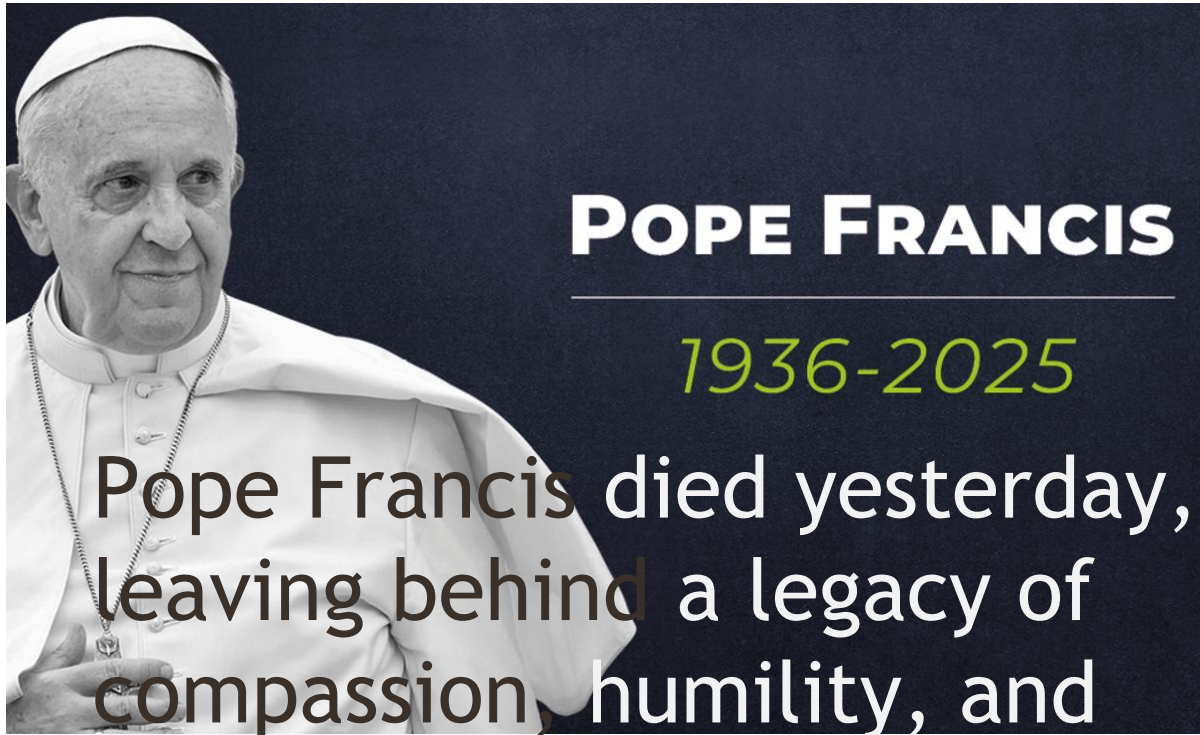

POPE FRANCIS

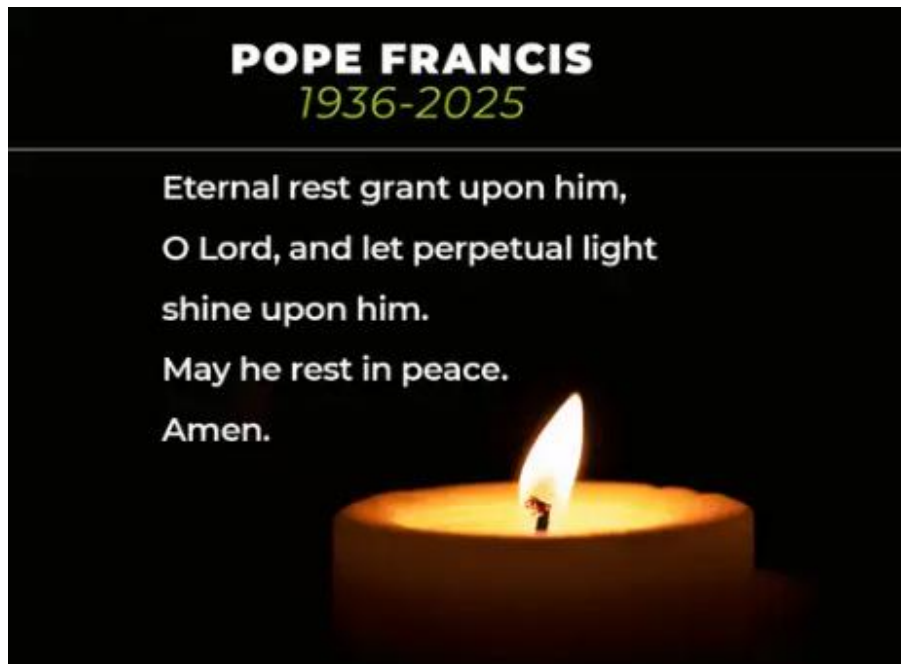
1936-2025

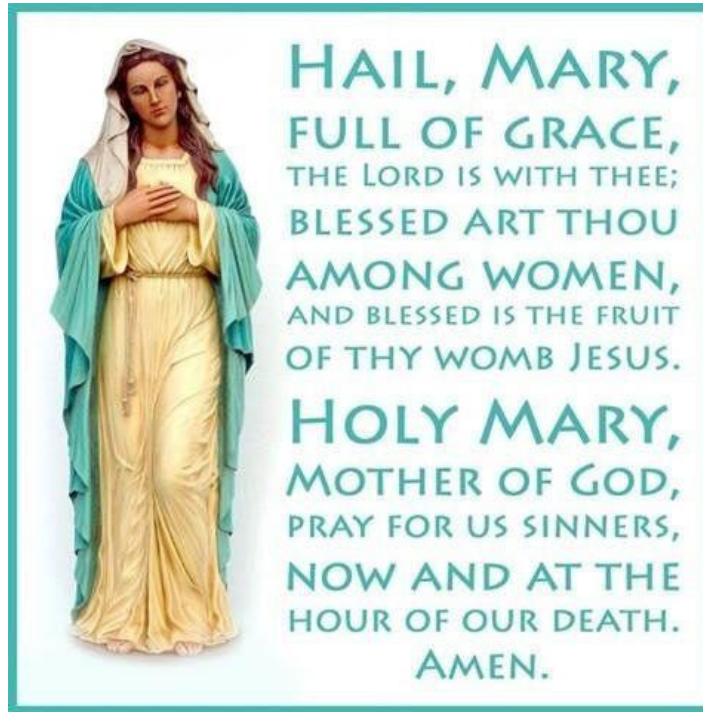
