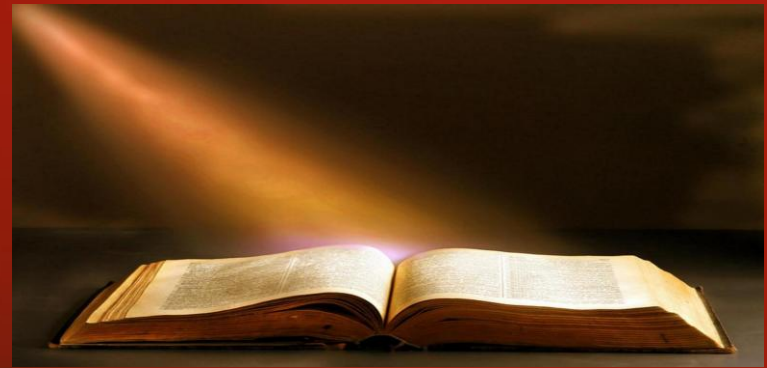

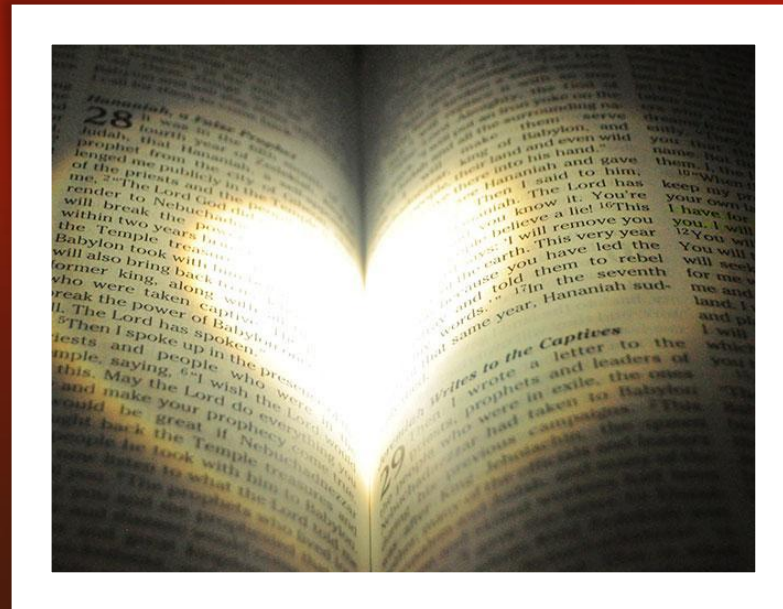

Sunday was the feast of Pentecost.

We remember that Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to be with his disciples.

Pentecost means 50 in Greek as the Holy Spirit came to the disciples 50 days after Easter.

He has asked them to love one another as he has loved them. And he says that God will send the Holy Spirit to be with them forever and to help them.

The Holy Spirit will teach the disciples everything they need to know once Jesus has left and will remind them of Jesus' words while he was with them.



Jesus also says that if we love him, his Father will love us and live with us.

In some versions of this gospel story, Jesus says that God will “make a home” in anyone who listens to his word.

This is another way of saying that God will always be with them.
